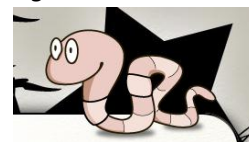

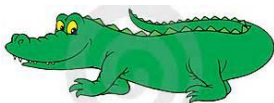
K-2 Athletics Carnival
