### Major Capital Works Update

#### Moving

As of this afternoon we will not be accessing the Admin Building, Library building, C Block (1/2MR and 2D) or the Support Unit anymore! Over the holiday period the contents will be moved to the demountable site. Thank you to the teachers who have been preparing for the move on top of writing reports and organising school events such as the Athletics Carnival, debating, recorder, NAIDOC Week, choir, Showcase etc.

#### Term 3 First Day And Demountable Procedures

Parents are asked to access the school through the gate at the eastern end of Rainbow Street. The Office will be located in the demountable building near this gate. Assisted School Travel and disabled access will still be available through the car park, across the front of the old Admin Block and into the playground.

Students will line up as normal when they return from school holidays. Teachers will then take them to their new classrooms.

We are asking that parents do not congregate on the deck area at all as this will disrupt students' learning. Please organise a spot in our playground to meet your child at 3pm. Teachers will walk students to the playground as usual. It is anticipated that we will have playground access for a few weeks after the break which is great as it will allow us get our new routines in place more easily.

#### 'Open House'

Of course we understand that parents are eager to 'check out' the demountable set up so we will have two 'open house' times. These are Wednesday 19 July 2017 from 8:30am to 9am or Wednesday 19 July 2017 from 3pm to 3:30pm.

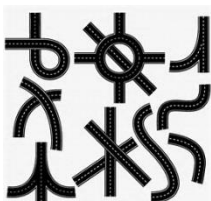

### REPEAT - Road Changes

From Friday 30 June 2017 the Kingsford Nine Ways roundabout will be replaced with traffic signals, as part of work to prepare for the CBD and South East Light Rail.

The intersection will be upgraded to make way for the Kingsford Light Rail interchange, a new transport hub

to provide better connections to bus stops and revitalise the surrounding area.

The removal of the Nine Ways roundabout will also result in a number of traffic changes:

- No right turn from Anzac Parade to Rainbow Street
- No right turn from Rainbow Street to Anzac Parade
- No right turn from Gardeners Road to Anzac Parade

Drivers should take extra care around the changed road conditions, allow extra travel time, take note of the changes to right turn movements and plan trips ahead of time.

Buses on Anzac Parade will continue as normal during this phase of construction. There may be minor impacts to some buses on Gardeners Road that use Nine Ways to access Anzac Parade southbound.
