Do you have a child in Year 6 going to High School next year? Do you have a child in Year 5 and you are

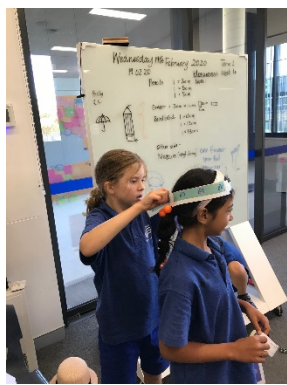
