What's Happening At Rainbow Street?

Last Friday you would have received the updated guidelines for Face-To-Face Learning. A number of school activities are able to resume albeit with strict guidelines.

Our school is in the process of working with our community users such as Directions in



Music, VIP Music and Sydney Chinese Cultural and Language School, to return these activities from the beginning of Term 3. There are strict requirements in place to protect the health and wellbeing of our school community and external providers must demonstrate compliance with these health and safety requirements. Each of our users has been asked to develop and provide plans showing how they will meet the requirements. We will keep you informed as to when activities are able to resume.

Additionally, to support contact tracing should it be required, there is additional paperwork to be completed by any external visitor to our school site. If you are asked to complete this, please do so.

The back gate will remain closed until rectification works are completed and school site access restrictions in place due to COVID-19 are lifted.

Randwick Campus Redevelopment

As part of the Hospital Road lowering works, the Hospital Campus B2 car park driveway accessed from Hospital Road will be temporarily closed 15 June 2020 – 15 August 2020. During the closure of the B2 car park driveway, please use:
