Fennelly Street

As you are aware we have had ongoing concerns about the width of the footpath at the rear of the school along Fennelly Street. This concern was heightened with the commencement of Stage 2 works on the Newmarket site and subsequent increase in construction traffic. The widening of the footpath at the rear of the school has been approved. Minutes from the August Randwick Council Traffic Committee Meeting state: That the proposed widening of the Fennelly Street footpath, over an approximately 60 metre length (along the northern boundaries of Rainbow Street Public School and the adjacent 'Scout Hall' land), and the subsequent extension westerly of the existing No Stopping parking control, is approved.

We understand that Council now needs to submit plans to the owner of the land, CBUS, for approval prior to any works commencing.

We will continue to agitate this along with other matters related to pedestrian safety and access, such as Kiss and Drop, currently with Council and Transport for NSW.

Newmarket Stage 2 - Construction Update September 2022 for Randwick Schools

Over the last few weeks you will have seen that the Newmarket Stage 2 site has started to change shape with the perimeter sheet piling nearing completion. Commencing on 23 September 2022 we will start removal of excess soil from site. This will see an increase in activity on the surrounding roads, the below diagrams highlight the approved traffic pathways for vehicle movement in and out of site. Following consultation with the local schools and Council, the traffic management plan has been amended to ensure that the running of trucks for removal of soil will not take place during school drop off and pick up times. Traffic control will also be in place to oversee truck movements and ensure community safety and adherence to the amended traffic management plan.

During the months of October and November we will undertake a number of piling activities, these works will be completed during our standard site operating hours of 7am til 5pm.
