Maintaining Your Child's Healthy Mind

To help your child manage stress, it's important to ensure their mind is in good shape. Think of a child's mind like a small but crucial part of a larger machine; it needs to work efficiently. Our minds help us process information from our senses (seeing, hearing, smelling, etc.) and make sense of situations, events, or problems. This process works best when our minds are well-rested and healthy.

In adults, a healthy mind can usually handle confusing or stressful situations and respond appropriately. For children, their ability to handle stress improves as they grow and learn. This means that as children get older, and as they are encouraged to solve problems, they get better at managing stress.

Studies show that even children who aren't typically anxious can become more anxious than adults in stressful situations. This is because their minds are still learning to cope with stress. Therefore, it's crucial for adults to create a supportive environment that helps children develop these important skills.

Over the next few Rainbow Ramblers, we will discuss how sleep, technology and YOU can help maintain a healthy mind for your child/children.
